Trinity Talks: Beyond the Classroom - These will take place on **Wednesdays at 4.00-5.20pm**. For each talk, a Trinity College academic delivers an interactive teaching session online, designed to stimulate students' super-curricular engagement, pitched at interested school/college students with an age-appropriate approach, designed to stimulate students' super-curricular engagement in a topic of wide interest to those thinking of potential further study or holding a general curiosity toward the subject.

The Access & Outreach team will also provide a brief overview of super-curricular enrichment and how it helps applications to Higher Education, and of the costs of Higher Education. Each session includes Q&A throughout for participants with the academic and the Access Team.

Six talks remain in the 2022 series, covering a wide range of subjects and all new for this year's programme:

27 April - Lunar Science

11 May - Biology & Medicine

25 May - Law

8 June - Development Studies & Public Policy (relevant to Geography, History, HSPS, International Law, International Relations, Politics, PPE & other subjects!)
