A message from Mrs Bibby:

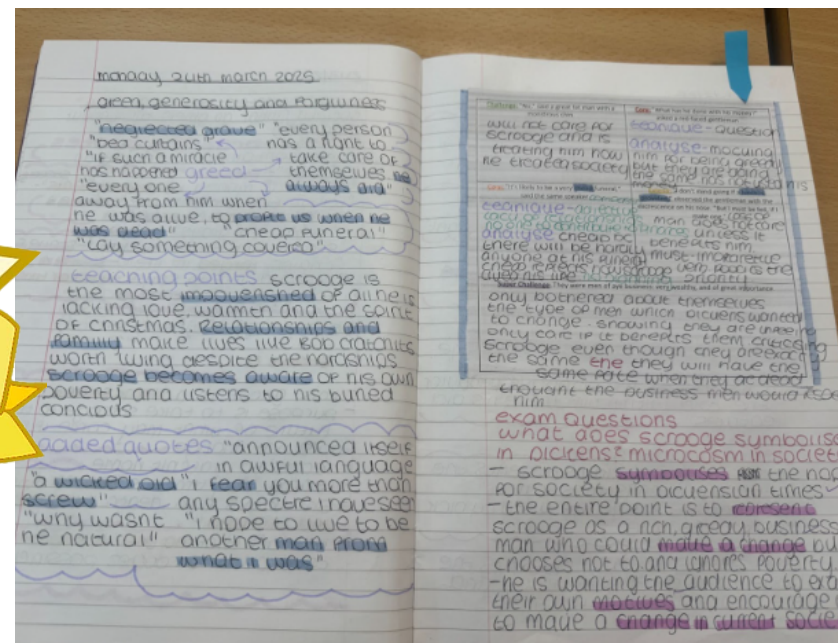
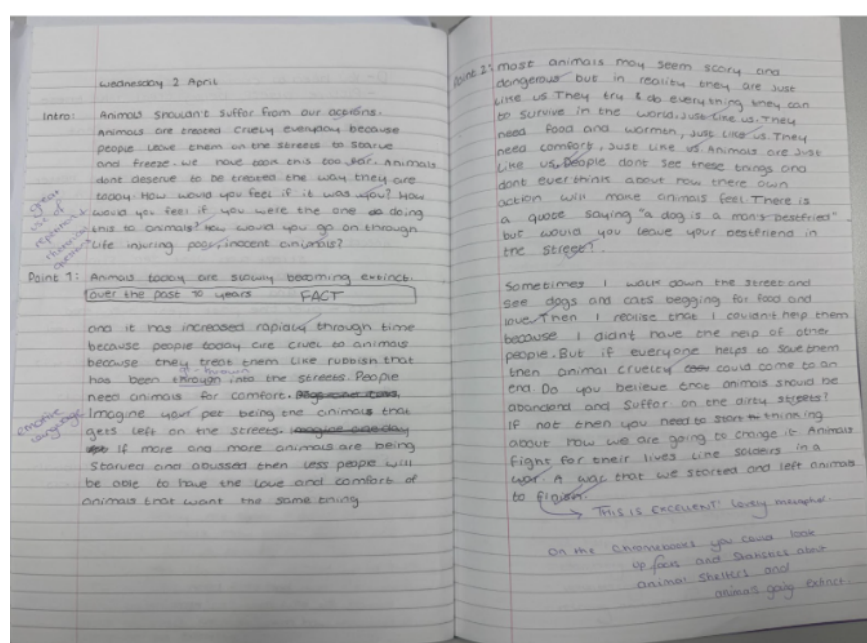

A Spotlight on Science...

Science covers three main areas: biology, chemistry and physics. In the summer term, year ten will be learning about topics from all three areas simultaneously with their specialist teachers. Students are building upon foundational knowledge gained in year 9.

Biology Topics: Evolution and Natural Selection, Plants and Photosynthesis

Chemistry Topics: Acids and Alkalis, Calculations involving Masses

Physics Topics: Motion, Particles and Density
