

A Message from Mrs Findlay

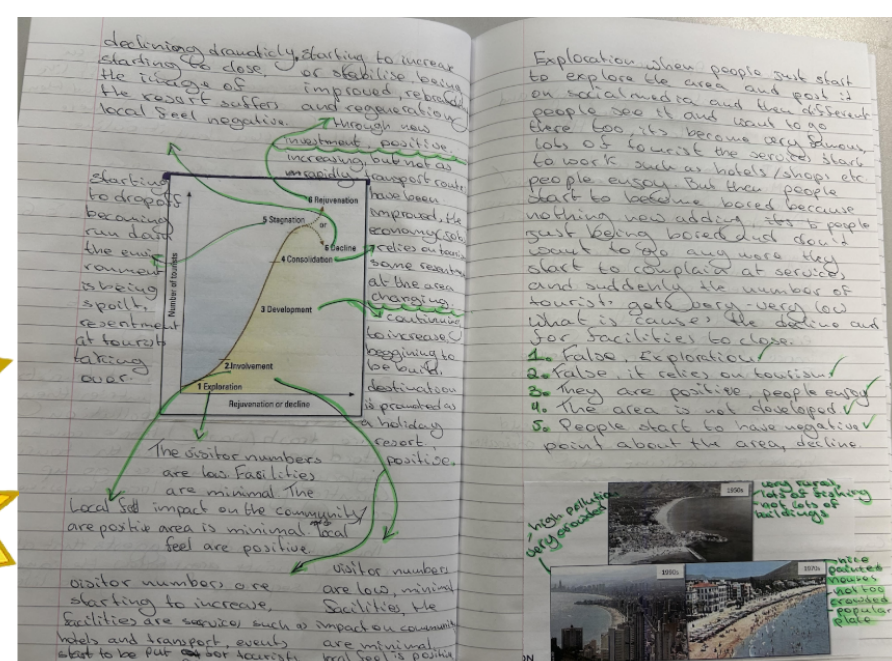
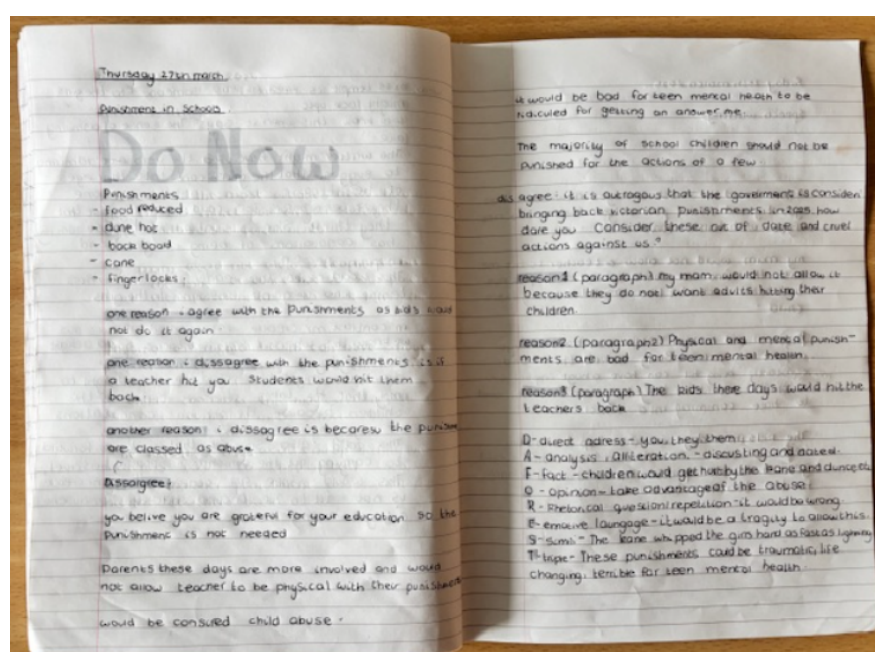

What an exciting term ahead! Summer brings the final term of Key Stage 3 learning for our Year 9 students. Students will spend the next few months predominantly studying geometry; beginning with exploring congruence when transforming shapes, before discovering Pythagoras' Theorem and then finally moving on to study similar shapes. There will also be a chance for students to recap their understanding of ratio and proportion and probability before the year closes.
